



## **CURRENT SUMMER CAMP OPENINGS**

**Term dates:** June 28 - July 26, 2026. \* *Staff are encouraged to arrive a few days early for meetings.*

**Venue:** Chester College International School, Santiago de Compostela, Spain. Santiago has an international airport, a 15 min drive away from the School.

### **Teaching context: Chester College's English Summer Camp**

*Chester College International School's summer programmes have been running every summer since 1985. They aim at providing a full educational and recreational experience for young people, aged 3-17, during the European summer month of July, with a special emphasis on the acquisition and development of communicative skills in English, through English lessons, Music, Drama, Sports, excursions and a wide range of recreational activities through English.*

### **Opening 1: Head of Drama - Job Description**

#### **Duties:**

- To direct and produce a Mid-Camp showcase (after 2 weeks) and the End-of-Camp Musicals.
- To run Drama workshops for different groups of campers, for about 5 sessions per day.
- To run rehearsals or Musical/Drama / Dance(Talent Show and other related activities, one or two evenings per week.
- To write personalised comments on the campers Progress Reports.
- To contribute to the overall running of the Camp.

Training and experience in Drama teaching and movement.

## **Opening 2: Head of Music - Job Description**

### **Duties:**

- To produce an inhouse Mid-Camp Showcase (after 2 weeks) and an End-of-Camp Concert / Musical, at a local professional Auditorium, in collaboration with the Drama Director.
- To run Music workshops for different groups of campers, for 4 or 5 sessions per day.
- To run rehearsals or Musical/Drama/ Dance/Talent Shows and other related activities one or two evenings per week.
- To write personalised comments on the campers' Progress Reports.
- To contribute to the overall running of the Camp.
